



“Overnight Savers” Rate Terms and Conditions

The following terms, and all terms and conditions set forth in Rate Schedule D1.13, apply to Customers who have switched their DTE Electric rate to the “Overnight Savers” Rate and Customer agrees to the following:

1. Beginning upon the first day billed on the Overnight Savers Rate, DTE Electric (“Company” or “DTE”) will provide, and Customer will accept, service under the Overnight Savers Rate for a minimum of 12 continuous months thereafter. After the initial 12-month term has passed, either Company or Customer may terminate by providing the other party three days’ prior notice of such termination. During the initial 12-month period, the Overnight Savers Rate can only be terminated by the Company, providing Customer with three days’ prior notice of such termination, should Customer be in violation of these terms.
2. Customer authorizes Company to switch its electric rate to D1.13, also known as the Overnight Savers Rate. After the electric rate is switched, the new rate starts with Customer’s next billing cycle.
3. The service is governed by the Overnight Savers Rate as set forth in Rate Schedule D1.13, which is on file with and has been approved by the Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC). Customer understands and agrees that all rates and applicable surcharges are subject to change per MPSC order, including Customer’s current rate schedule. To the extent there is any conflict between these Terms and Conditions and Rate Schedule D1.13, the terms in Rate Schedule D1.13 shall control.
4. Customer represents and warrants that Customer is the customer of record at the service address provided above and is authorized to approve participation in the Overnight Savers Rate.
5. Customer confirms the DTE Electric account in question currently has an active AMI meter, otherwise known as a “smart meter.”
6. Throughout Customer’s term on the Overnight Savers Rate, Customer agrees to maintain the eligibility requirements met and stated in the rate change request form or process when enrolled. Customer is a DTE Electric residential customer with an active AMI meter.
7. Estimated bills on the Overnight Savers Rate may be presented by the Company to the Customer via rate simulator or other channels. Prices shown may vary. Other charges (surcharges, taxes, etc.) will depend based on energy consumption. The estimated bills specifically in the rate simulator is based on your total electric usage for your previous 12-month billing periods (if available). Estimated bills are not guaranteed.
