Dynamic Peak Pricing Rate (D1.8)

This rate features three price tiers, as well as, Critical Peak prices for days when Critical Peak Events are called. It requires your home to have the advanced electric meter and may not be combined with any other tariff, rider, or separately metered service, other than Rider 18 (if available).

SPECIALTY RATE OPTIONS

These additional rates setup for particular equipment in your home are provided through a separate, secondary meter from the Base Rate. Separate wiring by a licensed electrician required.

Interruptible Space Conditioning Rate (CoolCurrents™) (D1.1)

This rate is for central air and air source heat pumps. Take advantage of a lower summer rate which can save up to 32% during peak hours from June through September when compared to the Time of Day 3-7 p.m. rate. You are required to provide wiring for a separate meter, which will be supplied and installed by DTE Energy. We may briefly interrupt your air conditioner or air source heat pump during times of high peak electric demand.

Green Rate Options

MIGreenPower - A voluntary renewable energy program for customers who want to attribute a greater portion of their energy use to DTE's renewable energy assets. By participating in DTE's solar and wind projects, customers are accelerating clean energy development in Michigan without installing a system at their home. Net Metering - Provides credit to customers with on-site generation and who fulfill DTE Renewable Resource requirements. This rate is no longer available to new customers.

Distributed Generation - A rate option, available after May 9, 2019, to customers with on-site renewable generation that comply with all requirements that supplies a credit for electricity sent back to DTE's grid.

Note, existing Net Metering sites will continue in the Net Metering program for 10 years from the date upon which the site began billing on the program.

Retail Access Service

An Electric Choice rate.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All electric rates are subject to surcharges and credits that vary by rate.

If you are 65 or older and are designated as head of household, you may be eligible for a \$4.25 per month senior citizen credit. There is no kWh usage requirement to qualify. To find out if you qualify, call (800) 477-4747.

*Residential Income Credit (RIA): Customers meeting eligibility requirements will receive a \$8.50 per month credit year-round. To find out if you qualify, call us at (800) 477-4747.
